Czech Embassy Cultural Attaché Robert Řehák will present a lecture on

*The Magic of Prague: Life and Legends of Czechs and Jews in the Heart of Europe*

at the Prince George County Regional Heritage Center, 6406 Courthouse Rd, Prince George, VA 23875

Thursday, June 30, 2016 from 7 pm -8:30 pm.

Admission is free. RSVP not required. Reception to follow.

Through legends, humor, and film excerpts, the lecture will reveal Prague's mysticism, delving into a thousand-year history of coexistence among Czechs, Jews, and Germans. The legends, like the story of the "Golem" by Mahral and the secret desires of Emperor Rudolf the II, give unique insight and uncover important messages for the ages. The lecture will also feature Franz Kafka's and Karel Čapek lesser known works, touching upon the crucial questions of human society's existence.

Dr. Robert Řehák is Cultural Attaché at the Czech Embassy in Washington DC, and a published scholar of biblical proper names and the Dead Sea Scrolls. He is proficient in five languages (Czech, English, Hebrew, German and Russian). He studied at Charles University in Prague, Ruprecht-Karls-Universität in Heidelberg and Hebrew University in Jerusalem. He holds M.A. and Doctorate degrees from Charles University and has lectured at New York University in Prague. He was President of the Society of Christians and Jews in the Czech Republic from 2000-2005 and thereafter served as Cultural and Press Attaché at the Czech Embassy in Israel. In recent years, he lectured about the history and legends of Czechs and Jews in New York, Washington, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Charlottesville, Michigan, and other cities in Israel and Europe. He is married and has four children.

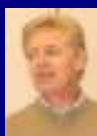

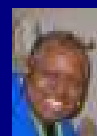

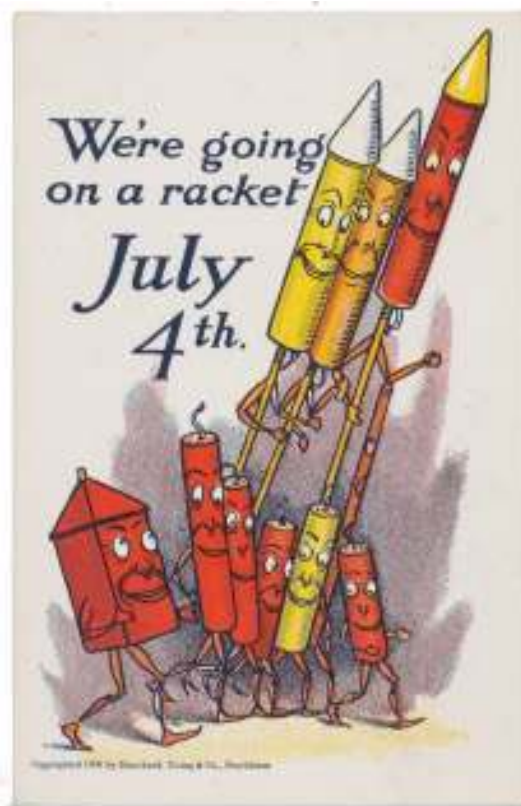
